

Evening MBA Full-Time Student

Please note that full-time students must meet state immunization requirements, carry health insurance, and pay student fees.

Note to International Students:

International students who are part-time and on a non-immigrant visa other than F-1 or J-1 and are considering full-time enrollment must consult with an International Student Advisor in the Office of International Programs to discuss a possible change of immigration status that would be appropriate for full-time study.

Health Services:

- Massachusetts Qualifying Student Health Insurance Plan (QSHIP) is a law that requires all college students enrolled in 9 or more credits to show proof that they have health insurance coverage while they are attending a higher education institution in the Commonwealth. The State further mandates that any student, who cannot show proof of having health insurance, must participate in an insurance program provided by their institution. **International students cannot waive the insurance with coverage from insurance carriers outside the US or with coverage by foreign National Health Services programs.**

- The State of Massachusetts mandates that all college students (graduate and undergraduate) be immunized against certain preventable diseases. These include measles, mumps, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria, hepatitis B, and meningitis. The requirement includes two doses of measles vaccine, three doses of hepatitis B vaccine and a tetanus/diphtheria vaccine within the past 10 years. Babson College requires that all students be immunized against varicella (chicken pox) or show that they are immune to the disease. The college must ensure that all students are in compliance with this State mandated immunization law; therefore a student's enrollment process cannot be considered complete until the immunization requirements are fulfilled. **Please refer to Health Services page for more information regarding immunizations.**

Parking:

Students taking 12 or more credits/semester are charged a yearly parking fee of \$50 on their tuition bill.
