Amendment I:

p. 40 under section “Major College Events and Student Organizations”

HONORS AND AWARDS

Graduation Honors

Honors at graduation are awarded to graduate students by program as follows:

- Summa Cum Laude: Students with the top 5 percent highest GPAs by program.
- Magna Cum Laude: Students with the next 10 percent highest GPAs by program.
- Cum Laude: Students with the next 10 percent highest GPAs by program.

The awards are determined based on GPA averages of all program graduates from within the current academic year.

Babson does not release the specific GPA cutoff information to students. Program is defined as students enrolled in the One-Year MBA, Two-Year MBA, Fast Track MBA, or Evening MBA programs. Honors for students enrolled in the Masters in Science in Accounting and Masters of Science in Management programs are calculated with the honors of graduate students in the Evening MBA program.

Honors at graduation are awarded to graduate students by program as follows:

- Summa Cum Laude: Students with the top 5 percent highest GPAs by program.
- Magna Cum Laude: Students with the next 10 percent highest GPAs by program.

The awards are determined based on GPA averages of all program graduates from within the current academic year. Babson does not release the specific GPA cutoff information to students. *Program is defined as students enrolled in the One-Year MBA, Two-Year MBA, Fast Track MBA, Evening MBA and MS programs.*

Amendment II:

p. 41 under section “Major College Events and Student Organizations”

The following awards are based solely on GPA:

- Lewis W. Mustard Award – A cash award presented to the candidate in the Two-Year MBA program who has achieved the highest cumulative GPA at graduation.
- Helen O’Brien Award – A cash award presented to the candidate in the Evening MBA program who has achieved the highest cumulative GPA at graduation.
- Award for Academic Excellence (One-Year MBA program) – A cash award presented to the candidate in the One-Year MBA program who has achieved the highest cumulative GPA at graduation.
- Award for Academic Excellence (Fast Track MBA program) – A cash award presented to the candidate in the Fast Track MBA program who has achieved the highest cumulative GPA at graduation.
