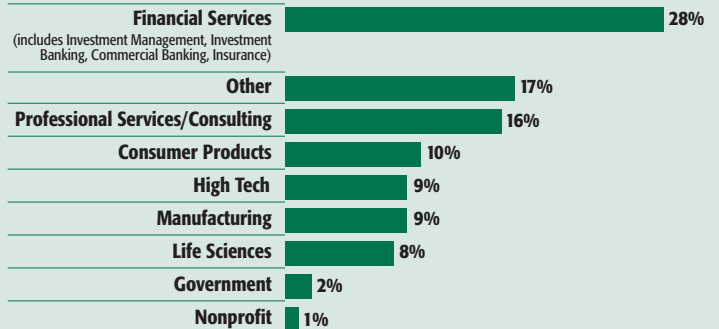

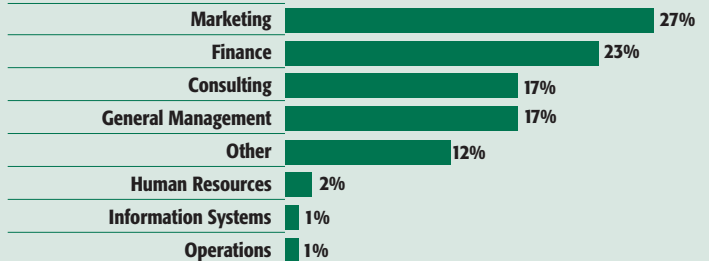

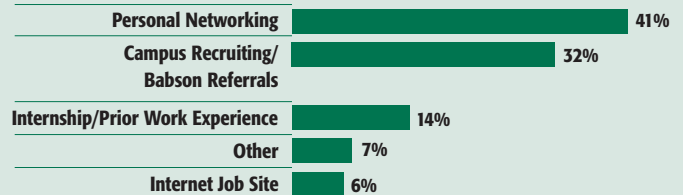
Industry Representation



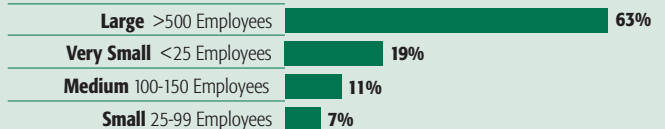
Functional Representation



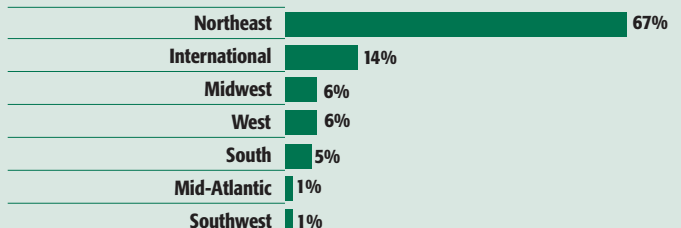
Graduates by Source of Employment
