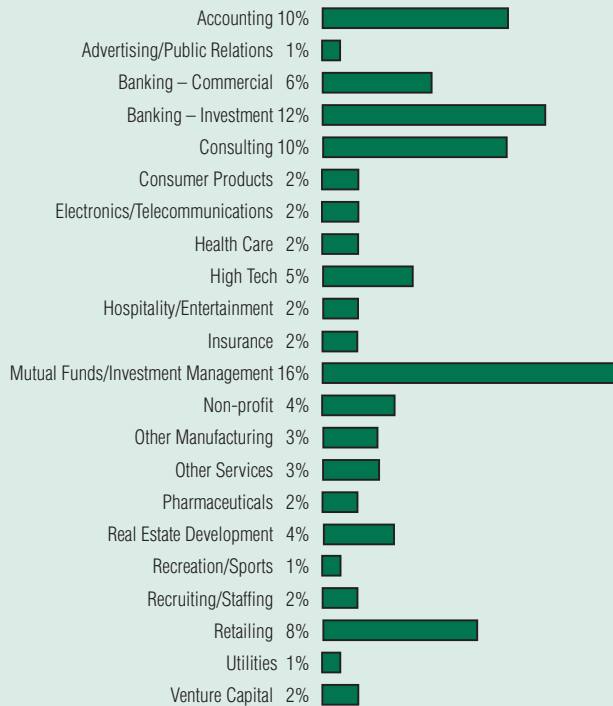

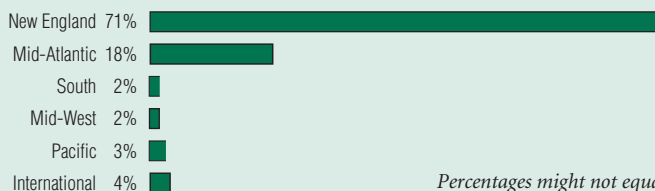
2001 HIGHLIGHTS

GRADUATES BY INDUSTRY



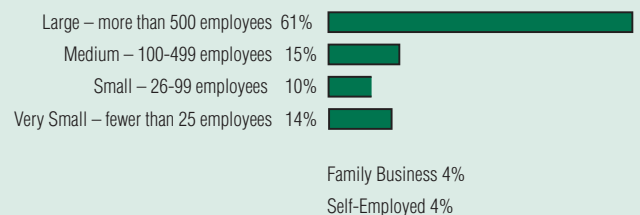
GRADUATES BY JOB LOCATION
